

2012 Fall Macomb County Republican County Convention Order of Business Quick Sheet

The following is the general flow of the county convention as prescribed by rules put forth by the Michigan Republican Party. The actual events may vary depending on convention rules adopted.

1. Registration – Credential Table
You Must Show Your Notice of Election as Delegate to County Convention

Full County Delegation (*delegates from the 9th and 10th Districts seated together*)

2. Open of Convention – Macomb County Executive Committee Chair (Barb VanSyckel)
Pledge of Allegiance / Invocation
Appointment of Temporary Officers
3. Nomination and Election of Permanent Chairperson of the Convention
This person will preside over business until the two districts are split
4. Appointment of Permanent Convention Officers and Committees - Permanent Chair

Congressional District Caucuses (*delegates from the 9th and 10th Districts seated separately*)

5. Open of Congressional District Caucus – Temporary Caucus Chairpersons
(9th District - Janice Nearon; 10th District - Stanley Grot)
6. Nomination and Election of Permanent Caucus Chairpersons
Conducted via Ballot or Role Call Depending on Rules Adopted
7. Appointment of Permanent Caucus Officers and Committees - Permanent Caucus Chair
8. Selection of Delegates and Alternates to State Convention
Conducted via Slate or Nomination from Floor Depending on Rules Adopted
District 9 will elect 88 delegates and 88 alternates
District 10 will elect 82 delegates and 82 alternates

Full County Delegation (*delegates from the 9th and 10th Districts seated together*)

9. Filling of Precinct Delegate Vacancies
If a vacancy exists in a precinct, a Candidate can present themselves at this time
10. Close of Convention
